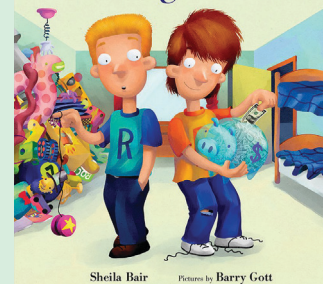

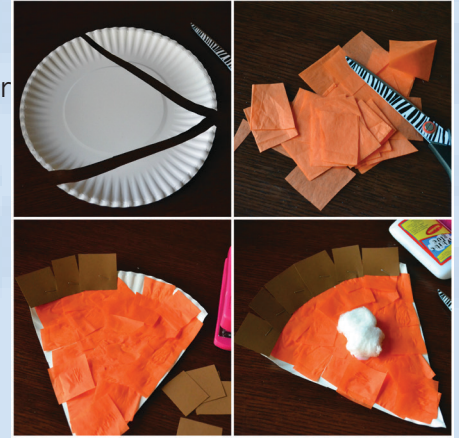

Pumpkin Pie Thanksgiving Craft

SUPPLIES:

- Large Paper Plate
- Orange Tissue Paper
- Brown Cardstock
- Glue, Scissors, & Stapler
- 2 Cotton Balls



Instructions:

1. Cut orange tissue paper into squares
2. Cut paper plate to resemble a pie slice
3. Put a layer of glue all over the paper plate piece. Cover the piece completely with the cut up tissue paper
4. Cut some squares out of your brown cardstock. This will be the "crust" of the pie
5. Once the paper plate piece is completely covered, staple the squares along the edge where the pie crust would be.
6. To finish, glue the two cotton balls in the center of the pie slice (because every pie needs whipped cream!)
