Banking for Kids

Each school year, the Compass Bank at School program runs from October through May, offering Oswego City school-district children the opportunity to deposit to their account, earn a small reward and enter into raffle drawings. Once a month, volunteers go to the five Oswego elementary schools – Kingsford, Leighton, Riley, Fitzhugh and Minetto – plus Trinity Catholic and Oswego Middle School to accept children's deposits. By making a deposit of any amount, children get to choose a small toy from our prize table and are entered into raffle drawings that take place at the end of the school year. This includes our "Millionaire for a Day" prize that grants the winner time in our inflatable cash vault, grabbing as much flying money as they can! Monthly reminders are sent home prior to Bank at School Day. Oswego Middle School students bank at the very beginning of the day. The other six schools do their banking during
