


A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

It was just about this time last year when we announced that our Bank at School program would be expanding to Oswego High School.

Through collaboration with the administration, teacher, Mr. Ben Richardson, and students in the OHS Inc. Business class, Compass opened up its smallest "branch" in April 2017. With mentoring and support from Compass staff, OHS Inc. students staffed the classroom-based



office to provide their classmates, teachers, and other high school staff access to Compass services a few times a week. Through this hands-on experience, the students built financial knowledge and honed their professional communication skills.

After a successful run from April to June 2017, Oswego High School not only invited Compass Bank at School program back, but also provided us a more visible location: the school cafeteria. In the 2017-18 academic year, we are again collaborating with Mr. Richardson and his students to deliver credit union services in the high school and provide experiential learning for the young people enrolled in this class. The visibility of the credit union has increased everyone's awareness of our presence, and has created opportunities for additional growth. With Bank at School now in every Oswego school, from elementary to middle to high school, Compass is excited to be able to serve its young members in strong and continuous ways. COMPASS OFFERS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Compass Credit Union is again sponsoring multiple scholarships to support its members' higher education goals. High school seniors who are Compass members are eligible to apply for the scholarship that Compass Credit Union co-sponsors with the New York Credit Union Association or for one of Compass's own scholarships. Compass annually provides two scholarships for graduating high school seniors worth \$4,000 apiece. In addition, Compass recognizes

that students engaged in continuing education beyond high school also benefit from scholarship support.

Therefore, we offer a one-time \$1,000 continuing education scholarship for a Compass member who has already graduated from high school and is pursuing additional education.

To apply for any of these scholarships, you must be a Compass Credit Union member who is either graduating from high school in 2018 or who graduated in 2017 or earlier graduate (for the \$1,000 continuing education scholarship only). You can download an application online at www. compassfcu.com or pick one up at any Compass office. Deadline for application submission is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 13, 2018.
