Merger will expand Compass Credit Union, offer more conveniences

ompass Federal Credit Union welcomes the members and employees of Heritage Federal Credit Union, as the two organizations merge, effective August 1, 2016. Compass management following the merger will consist of Compass manager Tom O'Toole, and assistant managers Denise Grinnell and Sally Godfrey. Godfrey will transition from her current role as Heritage Credit Union manager. "We are excited to provide former Heritage members access to our many services, such as Visa cards and mobile banking with Remote Deposit Capture at the same time as we expand locations and convenience to all our members," said O'Toole.

Godfrey says she looks forward to joining the dedicated staff of Compass. "I am excited about working with a Board and Staff that are committed to servicing and growing the entire membership without losing the personal relationships that we have established over the years."

O'Toole and Godfrey agree that the merger assures sustainability of their mutual goal: To become the membership's primary financial institution, by providing high quality personal service, with an emphasis on security of funds, competitive programs and continued growth.

Two members of the current Heritage Board of Directors, Lisa Vinciguerra and Michael Pisa, were unanimously voted to serve on the Compass Board, which will expand to 9 members, while the Compass staff will grow to 18 employees.





New Visa chip cards are available!

To help avoid identity theft and credit card fraud, Compass is implementing the use of chip card technology. These new Visa cards help ensure safer online and in-person transactions, offer a more thorough authentication process and help reduce the risk of identity theft. If you are a Compass Visa credit card holder, you can expect to receive a new chip card in the mail when your current card expires. Members leaving the country can request a new chip card prior to the expiration date of your current card. With this new technology, members must have their own individual card number, even if there are joint members on the same account. To actiate the newly-issued chip card, members are required to call from the phone number we have registered for you in our system. To update the phone number on your account, stop in or call Compass.

With the merger, all former Heritage offices will convert to Compass offices, expanding where members can do business from three to six staffed locations. In addition to the main office at 131 George Street and our current site-based offices at Novelis and Oswego Hospital, members can be served at the Hillside Plaza office in Oswego, on the SUNY Oswego campus in Culkin Hall, and the Canalview Mall office in Fulton.

Compass ATM locations will also expand. In addition to the ATMs at the George Street and Novelis locations, an ATM will be available in the SUNY Oswego Marano Campus Center, near the Chu Atrium bus stop. We offer members five free transactions per month at our many courtesy ATMs, including Empower, Oswego County FCU and Allpoint locations, which can be found at AllpointNetwork.com.
