Assistant Manager Denise Grinnell to Retire in January

After 32 years, Compass Assistant Manager Denise Grinnell, is set to retire in January.

Grinnell's tenure with Compass began in March of 1989 as a part-time teller, before moving to full-time in 1993.

In March of 1996, the credit union opened a new full-service branch on the west side of Oswego, with Grinnell promoted to Branch Manager. Over the course of the next ten years, this new branch attracted more than 1,500 new members, helping to move the credit union into its next chapter.

That next chapter came in 2006, with the opening of the credit union's current main office located at 131 George St. in Oswego. This transition saw Grinnell appointed as Assistant Manager, a position she has held for more than 14 years.

Under Grinnell's guidance, Compass has seen tremendous growth, now serving more than 7,000 members with six locations across Oswego and Fulton. During her more than 30 year tenure, the credit union's services for members have expanded to include mortgage and home equity loans, credit card services and more. (More on Page 3)

In lieu of the Giving Tree, Compass management agreed to set up two separate drives this Holiday season; one for Blessings in a Backpack and the other for Tunes for Tots.

Our food drive for Blessings in a Backpack took in boxed macaroni and cheese, peanut butter and jelly, canned tuna and chicken, fruit snacks, pop tarts, applesauce cups and more to help feed elementary students.

Now in its eighth year, the Oswego/Fulton chapter of Blessings in a Backpack helps to feed more than 400 elementary students in the Oswego and Fulton communities.

The Compass Tunes for Tots toy drive helped to provide toys to children and families in need throughout Oswego County.

Formed in 2010, Tunes for Tots has worked closely with Toys for Tots to help set up drop locations through-



out the county to help make a brighter Christmas for families in need.

Compass Donates More than \$10,000 to Area Schools for Clothing Needs
