### Enhanced online bill pay begins Oct. 20

"Bill Pay e-Plus" offers quicker payments, new features

n October 20th, members who use our convenient online bill pay service at Compass will experience a new look to the site and several user-friendly improvements as part of an upgraded "Bill Pay e-Plus" program.

Here are some of the enhancements:

- O Expedited payments
- O Person-to-person payments
- **O** Gift and donation payments
- O Subscriber call center
- O A new calendar visual for reminders or making payments
- O Optional "memo" information and e-mail notifications

When the new system begins, all of your payees will carry over to the new system as well as any scheduled payments and up to 18 months of payment history. Your current cleared check images will not be available within this new, upgraded system. However, they will be available through the system's call center and through the credit union. On October 20th, your new payment history and cleared check images will be recorded as payments process.

## **New Christmas Club option** available to all CU members

If you like to save money for Christmas, Compass now has a Christmas **■**Club option that eliminates some of the temptation to withdraw it early. In this option:

- Members put money into their Christmas Club account during the year and receive the total amount during the first week in October. The first Christmas Club payout will be in 2010.
- Partial withdrawals before October will not be allowed. Members wishing to close their account early will be charged a \$5 fee, and no interest will be paid for that quarter.
- O During the first week in October, members will have the option of receiving a check at home or having their Christmas Club money transferred to another account at Compass.

Compass will continue to offer its current service of allowing members to save money in a special account that can be accessed at any time of the year with no penalties for withdrawing early.
